

Health and Safety Policy

Nationwide Specialist Services Limited is committed to ensuring that the health and safety of its employees, temporary staff and contract staff is not adversely affected by their work and that its activities do not put at risk the health and safety of others, including its suppliers, customers, contractors and members of the public.

The company commits to proactively work towards;

- Assessing the occupational health and safety risks, and to take steps to prevent injury and ill health to all personnel
- Ensuring compliance to all applicable occupational health and safety regulatory requirements, as well as any other requirements to which NSS subscribes
- Continually improving our OH&S management system, by setting and achieving higher performance goals
 and objectives. This shall include the reduction of OH&S incidents, providing a healthy work environment
 and moving towards a zero injury organisation
- Active consultation and participation with all employees on matters relating to health and safety
- Promoting a positive health and safety culture

To achieve this it will, as far as reasonably practicable, provide:

- Well maintained equipment and systems of work.
- Suitable, well maintained plant.
- Suitable arrangements for the use, handling, storage and transportation of articles and substances.
- Adequate information, instruction, training and supervision.
- Defined roles and responsibilities for all employees as defined in the HSE Policy Manual
- Safe premises and work places, including access to and egress from them.
- Safe working environments with adequate welfare facilities.
- Communication and advisory facilities as required.
- Effective monitoring of safety standards.
- A dedicated health and safety committee representative of all levels of the organisation
- Assurance of protection from undue consequences where workers remove themselves from work situations that present an imminent and serious danger.

All employees shall be aware of, and must comply with, their individual and collective responsibilities as defined in this document.
